Miklós Neményi graduated at Budapest University of Technology as a mechanical engineer. He started his professional career at an agricultural engineering college. And after seven years he went to work for the Faculty of Agricultural and Food Sciences of the University of West Hungary. In the period between 1987 and 2012 he led the Institute of Biosystems Engineering. He spent 3 years in Germany as a guest researcher and guest professor, between 2006-2010 he was vice-president of the European Society of Agricultural and Engineers. At present he is also guest professor at Vienna University of Technology. Between 2008 January and 2012 December he was vice rector of University of West Hungary, responsible for research and international relations. He is corresponding member of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences. He was for ten years a co-chair of the seminar of Columbia University entitled: Pollution and Water Resources for ten years.
